Tallahassee--Florida Renewable Energy Producers Association has filed paperwork to form the Florida Green Energy Initiative, a political action Committee for the purpose of a ballot initiative to create Florida's Renewable Energy Portfolio Standards and a Florida Clean Energy fund aka Public Benefits Fund.

"While we will continue to work on a variety of renewable energy policy mechanisms in the Legislature, it has become crystal clear to us that the ballot is the only way Florida will ever see policy that truly drives renewable energy in the state," said Michael Dobson, FREPA President and CEO.

FREPA is a Florida not for profit dedicated to developing public policy that levels the playing field for renewable energy businesses in Florida so that it is a more competitive marketplace. Founded in 2007, FREPA has been the most aggressive voice in renewable energy discussions in Florida, therefore called "The Voice of Renewable Energy in Florida."
